
HANDS ON ACTIVITY













REFRACTION through rectangular glass slab

Refraction occurs due to change in medium density causing light to bend. This experiment demonstrated the principles of refraction. This phenomenon observed by grade-10 students under school premises.

AWARD CEREMONY










