



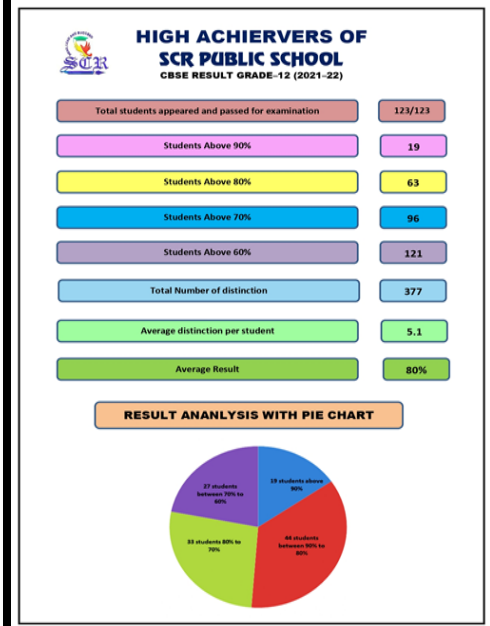
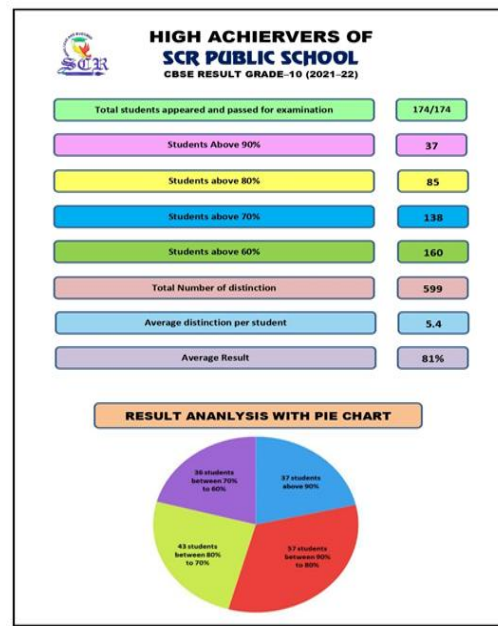

WHAT IS TEEJ?

Teej is a festival that is celebrated most commonly in the northern parts of India and is not one, but actually a collection of three different celebrations. Teej puja is normally a celebration for women, where they pray to Lord Shiva and Devi Parvati and rejoice in their union. It is believed that unmarried girls keep this fast to attain a husband like Shiva and married women pray to Goddess Parvati that their married life be as blessed as the holy one. The festival is also meant as a welcome to the monsoon season, as a good monsoon will ensure a good harvest. Teej technically refers to the third day of the month, after the new moon, and the third day of the month, after the full moon of every month, as per the lunar calendar. The festival, which is celebrated during the monsoon season is meant to welcome the rains, but also the greenery and bounty of nature that ensues. Women get together to celebrate this festival by wearing bright clothes, sharing sweets and gifts, singing, dancing, and playing on swings.
